STATEMENT

Since graduation in 2004 I have focused on kiln formed glass from my Perth studio.

I have 2 distinct looks – linear & painterly.

Linear - I am attracted by the orderly, colourful and repetitive patterns seen in vintage design of the 60's and 70's as they appeared on the mass market eg textiles, wallpaper and home wares.

Painterly – like many artists it is strongly influenced by the Australian landscape which offers wondrous colours, shapes and complexity.

I am fascinated by the fact that microscopic imagery of glass closely resembles the landscape, and realise that nature is more wonderful by accident than humans could possibly contrive.
